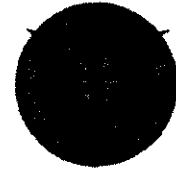

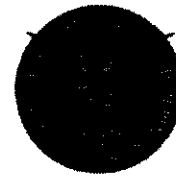

1. Justification

Since its inception in 2012, the International Joint Conference on Society and Health has brought together scholars and academics from various countries in the Southeast Asian region to discuss issues that are pertinent to health, social inequity and the issue of globalization. Now in its fourth incarnation, the conference promises to be a platform from which ideas, research findings and arguments regarding scholarly works in the area of Health Social Science may be discussed.

The Faculty of Social Sciences and Humanities, Mahidol University, Thailand and The Department of Behavioral Sciences, De La Salle University, Philippines jointly organizes the international conference themed “Global Health, Society and Human Development”. The conference orbits the following:

1) Knowledge of the impact of globalization on inequity is not clearly known. Globalization has accelerated in the past few decades and both informal connection in terms of people and information mobility and formal connection such as FTA and AEC are high. While in general, integration will occur in the region, the impact of this integration and globalization on inequity among the people is not known.

2) Inequity is very important issue. In the past development has emphasized on growth either in terms of GDP, literacy rate, health status or development. However, mal-distribution of wealth, power and resources within and among the countries in the region and among the regions have had happened in many high growth rate countries, consequently resulting in social and political unrest or unsustainable growth.

3) Knowledge about the impact of globalization is in the hand of Western scholars. In the past each country in this region tended to send their scholars to study in the developed countries, and they have learned from and connected with Western scholars. Knowledge exchange and Asian scholar mobility within the region is low. Consequently, the Asian region has a low rate of social networking among Asian scholars.

4) Mahidol University and De La Salle University both realize the importance of working beyond present boundaries. Both institutions have aimed to expand cooperation between the two universities to include all of the AEC countries to fill knowledge gaps and create the AEC scholar community to solve the problem of inequity. The fourth installment of the joint international conference is a means towards this end.

2. Objectives

The conference aims at:

- Encouraging scholars to improve their knowledge in social, developmental and health inequities and globalization with respect to the ASEAN and share their knowledge at the conference.
- Building a network of scholars in the ASEAN who will share ideas and findings on issues relevant to society, health, development and globalization.
- The conference will act as a catalyst to reduce inequity in ASEAN Countries via policies that can be forwarded to the AEC Council.

3. The conference main theme:

“Global Health, Society and Human Development”

Areas of interest of the conference include:

- Global health and challenges: situations and trends
- Social determinants of health
- Inequity in health
- Transnational health and international health care
- Emerging infectious diseases and society
- Substance abuse/disorders , including tobacco use and society
- Aging society
- Sexual reproductive health and gender issues

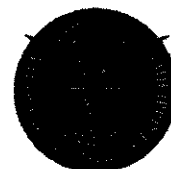
